Students will have received confirmation about which secondary school they will be attending next year, which we know has prompted much excitement within the community.

The Year 6 students have been doing an amazing job throughout remote learning and we are all really proud of their commitment and detication to their learning,

## READING

'TODAY A READER, TOMORROW A LEADER'

This term our focus has been on analysing non fiction texts. This has been used across both reading, writing and for CBL. This has given our learners a great chance to see how reading is used for all subjects and life.

We are moving into Fiction texts again for the remainder of the term. Here are some ways you can support your children at home:

- Encourage your child to read a variety of fictional texts.
- Discuss the characters in the book and the traits they are showing.
- Talk about favourite or important parts of the text.
- Having your child read their story to you.





It is important that students are completing Independent Reading at home for 30 minutes each day. We encourage students to discuss their individual reading goal with a family member at home so they can talk about the strategies they are using and share their success.



We celebrate Independent Reading through a Reading Night's Wall display. Here, students can track how many nights they have read and it is displayed right here in our community.

#### 'WORDS HAVE POWER'

This term in Maramba our focus for Writing is reports.

We have explored a variety of report types with the focus on book reports and news reports.

We've had a closer look at the features of what makes a good report and used that to improve our writing.

We have created book reports for our HHPS community to recommend texts for teachers that would be great for teaching our younger readers.

We have become the HHPS news report team, where we have created a range of news articles in different forms showcasing events from the Athletics Carnival, to strange animal sightings in the area.

If there's a news story to cover, the Year 6 students are ready to report it!









## **NUMERACY**

### 'MISTAKES ALLOW THINKING TO HAPPEN'

It has been a great term of Numeracy. It is so good to see the students trying hard and making progress. The topics that we have covered so far:

- Fractions specifically looking at strategies to add and subtract various fractions with the same or related denominators.
- Fractions connecting fractions, decimals and percentages.

The students have had three weeks on each topic. If the students would like to the revisit these then they can access My Numeracy on Essential Assessment to work through their misconceptions and practice further.

The topics that we will be covering second half of the term are mentioned below. If you would like to get a head start on these for home learning then there are plenty of activities on Mathletics which students can access.

Problem Solving and Reasoning is a big part of numeracy and we focus on this every week during challenge Monday. This is a way for students to use their prior knowledge to think critically about a problem.

## Term 3 topics

#### **Number & Algebra - Fractions**

Solve problems involving addition and subtraction with the same or related denominators.

#### **Number & Algebra - Fractions**


Make connections between equivalent fractions, decimals & percentages. Find a simple fraction of a quantity where the result is a whole number.

#### **Measurement & Geometry - Time**

Interpret and use timetables. Measure, calculate and compare elapsed time.

#### **Measurement & Geometry - Angles**

Investigate angles on a straight line, angles at a point and vertically opposite angles and use results to find unknown angles.

## CHALLENGED BASED LEARNING



In Term 3, we have been exploring the cross cultural connections between Indigenous Culture and our multicultural community. For the remainder of the term, learners will be continuing to deepen their understanding of Australian History and develop either a video or podcast about their chosen aspect of Australian History that they are interested in.




Problem solving was a big focus during the first three weeks of Personal and Social. We looked at problems that may arise individually and in groups, and ways that we can approach solving a range of different problems.

### THE BFG CHARACTER TRAITS




