Mother's Day






Education Week

Reading

This term the grade 5 students have been exploring non-fiction texts. We have begun the term by focusing on our first non-fiction goal which is identifying information that is important for understanding the text. We will continue to work on skills related to the following goals:

- Understanding the importance of information and themes being provided and make connections to them.
- Synthesising new information and discussing how it has changed our thinking.
- Understanding the structure, organisation and text features included in non-fiction texts.
- Identifying the style and idea behind non-fiction texts.

In addition to this independent reading will still remain a big focus with students given the opportunity to read and respond to texts.






Writing

This term we are focusing on explanation writing. An explanation text will explain 'how' or 'why' something occurs. Some topics we have written about are, "How does a plant grow?" or "How to get a HHPS hero token."

Students have been focusing on using specific vocabulary, particularly Tier 2 and 3 words.

Students will also use cause and effect vocabulary such as 'because', 'so' and 'due to', to explain how something happens.



Numeracy

This term in Numeracy we will be focusing on the following topics:

Weeks 3 - 4: Multiplication and Division

During these weeks students will focus on identifying and calculating factors and multiples of using number sequences. Students will be developing and using mental strategies to solve problems, including multiplication facts

Weeks 5 and 6: Patterns and Algebra

Students will be investigating number sequences. Students will use the four operations to solve problems involving number patterns. This include finding unknown quantities in different questions types.

Week 7-8: Time


Students will be using their knowledge of time to converting time from 24 hour time to 12 hour time.

Week 9- Revision

During this week students will have the opportunity to revisit past topics to revise and further develop knowledge.


At Home Learning Module- Measurement
