HHPS PREP CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

TERM 4

READING



Students will work through the following skills:

- identify the sounds that the digraphs qu, ou, oi, ue, er and ar make
- stretching the sounds in words, e.g. c-a-t /cat/, m-oo-n /moon/
- identify the features of a narrative, e.g. characters, setting, problem and solution

WRITING



Students will work through the following skills:

- write a simple story that includes some features of a narrative, e.g. characters, setting, problem and solution
- form uppercase and lowercase letters of learnt sounds
- experiment with full stops and capital letters

NUMERACY



Students will work through the following skills:

- represent practical situations that involve equal sharing and grouping
- identify and compare the length, capacity and mass of objects using words such as short/long and heavy/light
- partition numbers to 10, e.g. 5 and 5 make 10

PERSONAL & SOCIAL



Students will work through the following skills:

- learn to play together in fair and friendly ways
- identify likes and dislikes
- reviewing school expectations of 'Being your Best', 'Being Respectful' and 'Being Safe'

Inquiry



Students will work through the following skills:

- identify ways we can be healthy, e.g. washing our hands, brushing our teeth, staying active and eating healthy foods

HOME LEARNING



We encourage you to:

- read to or read with your child everyday and record this in their yellow journal
- practise their counting goal
- practise their Tricky Words found in their Home Learning folder
- utilise online subscriptions

PE



In this unit, Prep students will **revise their Fundamental Movement Skills** such as running, jumping, throwing, and catching. They will also **explore fun games from around the world**, learning new ways to play and move. Throughout the lessons, students will focus on **working together, sharing, and cooperating** with classmates to enjoy activities safely and positively.

PERFORMING ARTS



This term, students will explore key elements of drama through fun games and activities. They will learn about role and character, movement, voice, space, and time, developing skills to express ideas and emotions. Students will also participate in improvisation, using prompts and props to create spontaneous and imaginative performances.

SCIENCE



In Term 4, the students will be exploring how the weather and seasons change throughout the year and how it affects the things we can do. They will also engage in learning about the moon and the stars.

VISUAL ARTS



Students will complete a series of creative projects exploring colour, texture, and 3D form. They will make an Alphabet Soup artwork, create Truffula tree sculptures inspired by The Lorax, design a Rainbow Fish collage, and explore printmaking by making space artworks.
