Years 1 & 2



Year 1-2, students have taken their Spanish learning by storm this year! Students have learned how to say the names of current events and holidays in Spanish (¡Feliz día de San Valentín!) Students will be learning how to say the names of body parts in Spanish. We will be singing Spanish songs such as "Cabeza, Hombros, Rodillas, Piés" (Head, shoulders, knees and toes). Year 1-2 students will also be focusing on Spanish culture this term. We will be learning about all 21 Spanish-Speaking countries, and where they are in the world. We will conclude the term by focusing on the countries of Spain and Mexico. ¡Muy bien!





Years 3 & 4

Year 3-4 students have been excelling at Spanish this year! Students have continued their Spanish learning by interviewing a partner and recording their answers in Spanish. We have been learning how to say what the weather is in Spanish (hoy es...soleado, ventoso). As Term 1 continues, students will create their own weather report video in Spanish using a green screen! ¡Asombroso!



Years 5 & 6

Year 5-6 students have been practising conversational Spanish. This term, students are learning about Spanish language and culture. We have been focusing on Spanish media and the impact it has on our society. Each student will be creating their own project about a piece of Spanish media and how it has helped them learn about Spanish language and culture. They will be presenting their projects and teaching their community new Spanish vocabulary. ¡Perfecto!
