#### Year 3/4 Chinese ink painting

The Year 3 and 4's are learning Chinese ink painting using traditional brushes and techniques. So far we have learnt how to paint bamboo and cherry blossom using chinese calligraphy brushes. We have explored the long format of Chinese scroll painting and will be making our own mini cherry blossom scroll paintings.







#### Year 5/6 - Clay Sculpture

The Year 5 and 6 classes are planning for a Clay Sculpture of their own design, thinking of how to make the work and what tools they will use. We are currently in the design phase. We are looking at how to slip, score and join and learning about the use of the clay tools, which will assist in the planning and making phase. In Term Two, our Prep students will continue to refine their throwing skills before making connections with catching. Prep students will then participate in a gymnastics unit working on their balance, rolling and skipping. The term will finish with a brief dance unit where students will learn and perform a simple dance.



## **YEAR 1+2**



Our Year One and Two students will explore key fundamental skills of Striking and Fielding before moving into their gymnastics unit. In Gymnastics students will focus on balance, stretching, rolling and hopping. Year One and Two students will finish their term with a dance unit focusing on making and performing.

## **YEAR 3+4**

Term Two will see our Year Three and Four students focus on striking and fielding before applying the skills in minor games. Students will then move into a Gymnastics unit looking at different movements. Our final focus for the term will also be Dance where students will create, perform and discuss their dance.



## YEAR 5+6



Throughout Term Two our Year Five and Six students will explore striking and fielding in activities and minor games. They will also complete a unit on Gymnastics and Dance. Year Six students will also participate in weekly Interschool Sports rounds. The sports this term are Netball, AFL and European Handball.

Our Prep learners have been working on building their understanding around friendship and identifying what makes a good friend. Students have been working on how they can be a good friend by identifying 'friendly' and 'unfriendly' behaviours. They have been exploring this through stories, drawings and modelling this through play and team building activities. Later this term, they will be exploring emotional responses based on their actions and practising skills that will help them to continue to be good friends.





## **YEAR 1+2**





Our **Year 1 and 2** program focuses on developing students awareness of their own and others strengths in friendships and identifying qualities of a healthy relationship. They have begun the term with exploring what makes and doesn't make a 'good' friend and how how they can interact positively with others. They have demonstrated this by sorting statements that make a 'good' friend, role playing scenarios and collaborating in groups. Students will continue to use this knowledge later in the term to identify strategies they can use in solving friendship problems and how they can maintain a healthy relationship.

## **YEAR 3+4**

At the beginning of the term, our **Year 3 and 4** learners developed their knowledge on different positive traits in a friend and problems that can occur within friendships. As well as, how they can interact positively with others and work cooperatively. They then explored various problem solving strategies through role play scenarios and expanded their understanding on how our reactions can impact others. Students will now be exploring how they can promote health and wellbeing at HHPS.





## YEAR 5+6





Our **Year 5** and 6 program focuses on identifying positive and negative traits in friendships and how outside problems can cause us to get to a 3-5 on the feeling chart. Students explored different problem scenarios that can occur outside and identified various strategies to solve the problem. Students have begun looking at how our actions and emotional responses can impact ourselves and others. As well as, choosing the best strategy to solve the problem by looking at the positive and negative outcomes for each.

### Your 2024 Science Teachers



This term in Science, our Prep students are learning all about push and pull forces. Our Prep students began the term by exploring the forces of different toys, and will then look at how different shaped objects such as balls and blocks move.





## **YEAR 1+2**

In Year 1, students will be exploring forces, and looking at how different objects move according to their shape or size. In Year 2, students have started investigating how sound can be produced as well learning about sources of light.

## **YEAR 3+4**

This term, Year 3 students will be learning about laws of motion, and the role gravity plays in our everyday lives. Year 4 students have been exploring how heat can be produced or transferred. They will also investigate magnets and design a tool that uses magnetic force.





## YEAR 5+6

In Year 5, students have begun looking at light, and how it can be absorbed, reflected and refracted. They will learn about how the human eye perceives light. Year 6 students are learning all about electricity, including different types of energy and how to build a circuit.




### **STEAM Newsletter**

In Prep, students are learning to explore data around them. For example, a calendar tells us what day it is, and the clock tells us the time. Data is all around us! We will learn about simple data and also explore creating our own pictographs.

In Media, we will learn about photography. We will learn to take simple photos that are clear and purposeful.



### **YEAR 1+2**



In Year 1 and 2, will will learn how to use digital systems, such as an iPad, to create pictographs and bar graphs while exploring software.

In Media, we will learn about photography. We will explore different types of camera angles, like a close up, and we will make a picture story!

### **YEAR 3+4**

In Year 3 and 4, we will learn about representing data in different ways, as well as exploring codes and symbols. For example, we will explore how semaphore is used to communicate. We will also explore functions and shortcuts on Google Sheets.

In Media, we will learn about famous photography and camera angles, by working on our own portfolio.



## YEAR 5+6



In Year 5 and 6, students will explore binary code, as well as learn how to collect, sort and process data using functions in Google Sheets.

In Media, we will learn about photo editing. Students will develop skills such as removing a background from an image, using a green screen, among other editing processes.
